- To ensure that children under your supervision are woken up in the morning and go to bed at night including making sure the children remain hygienic (e.g. showering, brushing teeth and so on).
- Be on duty during the evening and making sure the children under your responsibility remain quiet and behave
- Applying all aspects of training and company documentation including child



protection and Health and safety

- Help in the preparation of the centre for the arrival and departure of clients by doing laundry, making beds and cleaning the building
- Protect and conserve all properties belonging to the Company
- Observe safe working methods
- Contribute to a harmonious working environment
- Assist in the continued maintenance of any Xplore centre
- Assist any person requiring medical treatment to get to a qualified First Aider
- Assist in the moving of equipment to and from Centres and the set-up, and take-down of that equipment when necessary
